Government officials' visit to incubator

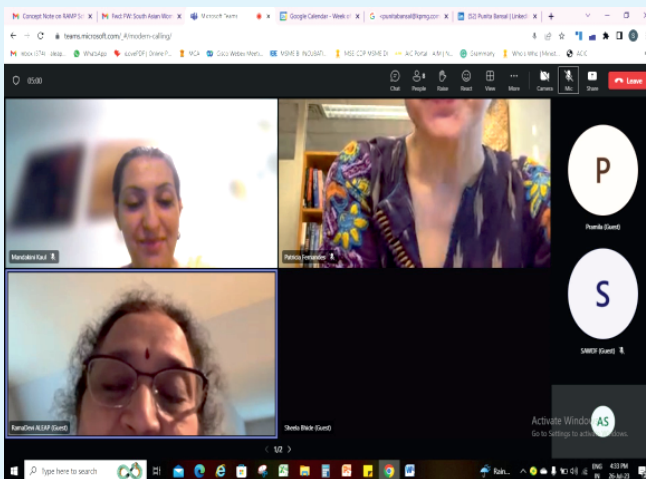
